6:40 Public comment (Petrina)

Patrick Lehr emailed in asking for SVT public comment to bring to light the farmer strikes in India. Petrina suggests coming up with a general statement related to farmer issues to refer back to for such events & the Communications Committee establishing guidelines for the future when things come up.

- 6:50 Directors Report (Dave)
 - Member Services & Programs
 - Dave spoke with Deepa lyer, the New Roots Program Manager from International Rescue Committee where they work with immigrant & refugee farmers. Their farmers are hoping to do some exchanges with established farmers especially around issues related to farming in the floodplain.
 - Reminder about the AUCTION
 - Farm Services Bruce Ford gave tour and happy hour of Molly Bear Farms. He will also be sharing in a lambing intensive.
 - Looking for hosts for virtual farm tours.
 - 20 candidates for the Farm Services Manager Position. 3 interviews already complete. The position won't be offered until approved by the board. The plan is to do a brief second-round interview with the 2 top candidates.
 - Buyer's site weathered the season well. March 8 USDA & Tilth Alliance tour to highlight work at the site
 - Advocacy

New SVPC executive director is on FFF. Dave continues to attend meetings and Libby Reed serves on caucus

- Organizational Strength

- Received \$32,000 in PPP loan.
- Dave G hopes to raise an additional \$50k in 2021 to meet our needed goal.
- Biz Impact Northwest wrote SVT into a grant with King County for \$5,000 for technical and biz support for farmers.
- Membership Campaign kicking off next week through the end of March to grow membership roster.
 - Send 1-3 sentence quote about importance of SVT membership to you and farm biz WITH a photo (for social media)
 - Review the list of current/recent members. Thank current members and invite lapsed members back into the community
 - Lapsed members have received notice that they are lapsed
 - Will receive an email directly from Dave

7:05 2020 Finanances (Dave)

 SVT able to reduce expenses below what was budgeted in 2020. Below on income by \$40,000 and down on expenses by \$100,000 which put us in the black by about \$53,000 Questions About the Budget:

\$191,000 in the bank today (with PPP loan disbursement)

Petrina - asking if we have or need an official reserve policy for times of surplus.

Dave G. feels that would be a good step for the organization and in-line with other non-profits that keep 6mos.-12mos. operating expenses in the bank. Dave C. suggests formulating a board resolution

Bruce Ford - suggests looking at current monthly spending rate to determine 6 month & 12 month spending to come up with a draft plan. Will bring findings to the next board meeting.

Vince clarifies that we're suggesting coming up with a specific reserve related to operating expenses. Brings up need to create a policy around regular review to ensure reserves stay up to date as spending changes over time.

Dave G shares that a policy will be helpful tool to further explain finances to potential and/or current funders.

- 8:05 Office Space Discussion (Dave)

Background: Carnation city hall will be deconstructed and then rebuilt. Will need to vacate space in September or October in 2021.

The intention is to rebuild a 3 story building with the second story earmarked for community space. The city hopes the tenants of the second floor come back after construction. Current plan is for second floor to be "gray space" with the tenants doing their own build-outs to suit their individual needs. The same square footage would be available. Do not yet have financials on cost of build and scope of build-out. Lease terms are not yet set, but their intention is to keep it below going rate.

Learning more about the new space and exploring new options. Petrina suggests the Executive Committee convene to discuss the long-term plan.

There is some urgency to create a timeline and stick to it. It could be budget impacting if the space is more costly. The current lease is \$175 for 800 square feet including electricity, heat, and water.
